

# TRAVEL CONSENT FORM

In addition to appropriate travel documents for your destination, both parents or legal guardian(s) (or the sole, documented custodial parent/legal guardian) must provide signed consent for a minor (under 18 years old) to travel in someone else's care.

In the case that the child lives with only one parent, the letter must be signed by that parent and be accompanied by a copy of the legal custody document or death certificate. Verify with the consulate of your destination if a notarized document is mandatory.
